

#### BY BIKE THROUGH BRETON NATURAL SPECTACLES

No other region in France is surrounded by more legends, myths and legends, and in no other region are language, costumes and customs more cherished than in Brittany. This mysterious land with its sea-swept cliffs, magnificent viewpoints and small, picturesque harbors gives the Breton landscape its own unique charm. A cycle tour is the ideal way to get to know this diverse landscape. Known for its fresh, excellent cuisine and its cheerful, cosmopolitan people, this cycle tour will be an unforgettable experience.



#### Day 1

Arrival in Dinard on the coast of Ile-et-Vilaine. After checking into your room, welcome with an aperitif at around 6.00 pm. Followed by the first Breton dinner. Bon appetit!

## Day 2 Fréhel - Cap Fréhel - Fort La Latte - St Cast 47 km

Travel by bus to the Fréhel peninsula. From here you cycle. The ride takes you to Fréhel Plage, where you are immediately greeted by a magnificent panorama. You cycle along the coast on panoramic routes, interrupted by magnificent views of the sea and its impressive coastal landscape. On arrival at Cap Fréhel, you say goodbye to your bikes for about an hour.






Cap Fréhel is best visited on foot. Cap Fréhel is one of Brittany's most magnificent natural spectacles with its 72-metre-high cap and is also an important bird reserve (so don't forget your binoculars!). You will take a one-hour tour of the Cap and enjoy the beauty of this place. The journey then continues by bike to Fort La Latte. Visit the fantastically situated castle and have a picnic lunch before continuing, partly through the interior, to St Cast de Guildo. Here you have the opportunity to take a refreshing dip in the sea.

#### Day 3 St Malo - Cancale 39 km


Today it's time to get your sabres ready! You ride your bikes directly into the former pirate and corsair town of Saint-Malo! On a tour of the town, you will learn more about the turbulent times of the corsairs and pirates. A tour of the 'Rempart' offers many different views of the bay around St Malo and it will certainly be difficult for everyone to tear themselves away from this atmosphere. But today is far from over. You drive out of St Malo with a magnificent view of the long beach in the suburbs of St Malo. We continue via Rotheneuf to the Point du Grouin. Take a short walk to catch a glimpse of the rich bird life at Point du Grouin. It's worth carrying binoculars with you.

Now the journey continues to the picturesque harbor town of Cancale. This is a famous oyster fishing center. During your stay, you will learn everything you need to know about oyster fishing and oyster farming. This is followed by an oyster tasting, right by the sea, which is also an opportunity to get to know one of the few wines of Brittany -Muscadet. A little tasting of the same, but watch out, our bike tour leads over a mountain out of Cancale! After this culinary end to the stage, we return to Dinard by bus.



## Day 4 Rancemouth - Dinan 68 km

From Dinard, the journey continues to the banks of the Rance. The cycle tour continues inland along the Rance estuary to Dinan. Beautiful! You will already get an impression of the charming landscape of the Breton hinterland. Guided tour through the pretty alleyways and little streets of the picturesque fortified town. Afterwards, it's time to head out: Pure nature! From Dinan, you cycle along the towpath of the Canal de la Rance and can relax and enjoy the picturesque landscape.

# Day 5 Vivier - Mont St Michel 49 km

Strengthened after breakfast, you cycle through the polders from Vivier-sur-Mer. After crossing the border river between Normandy and Brittany, the Couesnon, you will reach the world-famous monastery castle, the "Wonder of the Occident Mont Saint Michel", after around 24 km. Pilgrims, monks and knights once populated the mighty granite rock. The changing tides are also a hugely impressive spectacle and should not be missed under any circumstances. After an extended stay with a visit to the monastery, you cycle back across this vast marshland in the afternoon.

## Day 6 Dinard - Bike & Boat 26 km

Dinard, with its majestic Belle Époque villas and beautiful beaches, is the start of our coastal cycle tour. The morning cycle tour offers paradisiacal views, as does the sea trip planned for the afternoon. We board a corsair ship to admire the coast from the other side!
