Day 1 Montmartre district and surroundings 17 km

Arrival in Paris by midday, either by flight, train or car. Pick-up by France à Vélo at the train station. Check-in at the hotel in the heart of Montmartre. In the afternoon, you can set off on your first cycling tour around the Montmartre district.



Day 2 Quartier du Marais and Cité about 31 km

The Marais, once a moor, is now one of the most beautiful districts in Paris. Around every street corner there are new architectural sights, picturesque streetscapes and a typical charm that is immediately captivating. An atmospheric and varied district that is perfect for exploring by bike.

Perhaps the most beautiful square in Paris, the Place des Vosges, was built by Henry IV. An unknown architect is responsible for the predominant Renaissance style with its symmetry. Tournament games, royal receptions, weddings and duels took place on the square. The Marais is also the center of Jewish life in Paris. Continue in the afternoon to the 'Ile de la Cite'. Tour along the banks of the Seine and visit the Sainte Chapelle with its famous stained glass windows.

Day 3 Fontainebleau 40 km

A royal day. Off to Fontainebleau! Transfer out of Paris to one of the most beautiful castles of the royal families: Fontainebleau. Surrounded by a fantastic forest, much appreciated in the days of royal hunts, it is a fantastic cycling destination. Guided tour of Fontainebleau Castle. A royal cycling trip calls for a royal finish! During the delightful dinner, quel plaisir, in a restaurant with a lot of flair, the staff repeatedly transform themselves into opera singers. A fantastic atmosphere with wonderful cuisine and certainly an unforgettable evening.

Day 4 Quartier Canal St Martin about 28 km

After a short morning bike ride through awakening Sunday Paris, a visit to what is probably the largest flea market and antiques market in Paris is on the agenda. Marché aux puces! Stop for lunch at Lucette's. A simple but incredible Guingettes restaurant, where the chansoniers don't need to be asked for long to create a cozy atmosphere. In the afternoon, we will walk along the romantic Canal St Martin and make a stop at the famous cemetery "Cimetière du Père Lachaise", with some famous graves and interesting anecdotes.
