## Day 1 Arrival in Souillac

Once at your hotel you can take some time to visit the Benedictine monastery from the 12<sup>th</sup> century. See the remarkable abbey with fine carvings, and a statue of the prophet Isaiah, a masterpiece of Romanesque art.

## Day 2 Souillac - Saint Sozy 22 km

Along the river Dordogne, you can admire the castles of la Treyne and Belcastel, visit the famous « grottes de Lacave », and discover charming villages.



## Day 3 Saint Sozy - Carennac 22 km

This easy daytrip along the riverside of the Dordogne will lead you up to the brown roofs of Carennac, considered among the most beautiful villages of France.



## Day 4 Around Carennac 20 to 30 km

The valley of the river Dordogne in Quercy shows many different landscapes and richness of patrimony: Castles of Castelnaud and Montal, Grottes of Presque considered by Prince Henri d'Orleans as « the jewel in Europe's crown », and picturesque villages of Autoire and Saint Céré.

## Day 5 Carennac - Rocamadour 30 km

After leaving the valley, you can descend into the very heart of the earth: the gouffre de Padirac. The visit is breathtaking. Then you will cycle through the 'Parc Natural of Causses du Quercy' towards the marvellous Rocamadour.

## Day 6 Around Rocamadour 20 to 30 km

Enjoy a stroll through Rocamadour, the second most visited place in France. On your today's ride you can discover the Causse Quercynois and its capital Gramat.

## Day 7 Rocamadour - Souillac 27 km

You will cycle along the valley of Ouyse and admire the Moulin de Cougnaguet, before arriving in Calès. This village offers a beautiful panorama of the Causses. From here, you cycle back to the valley of Dordogne and back to Souillac.
